Did you know that approximately 1 in 8 British adults worry about not being able to afford enough food?

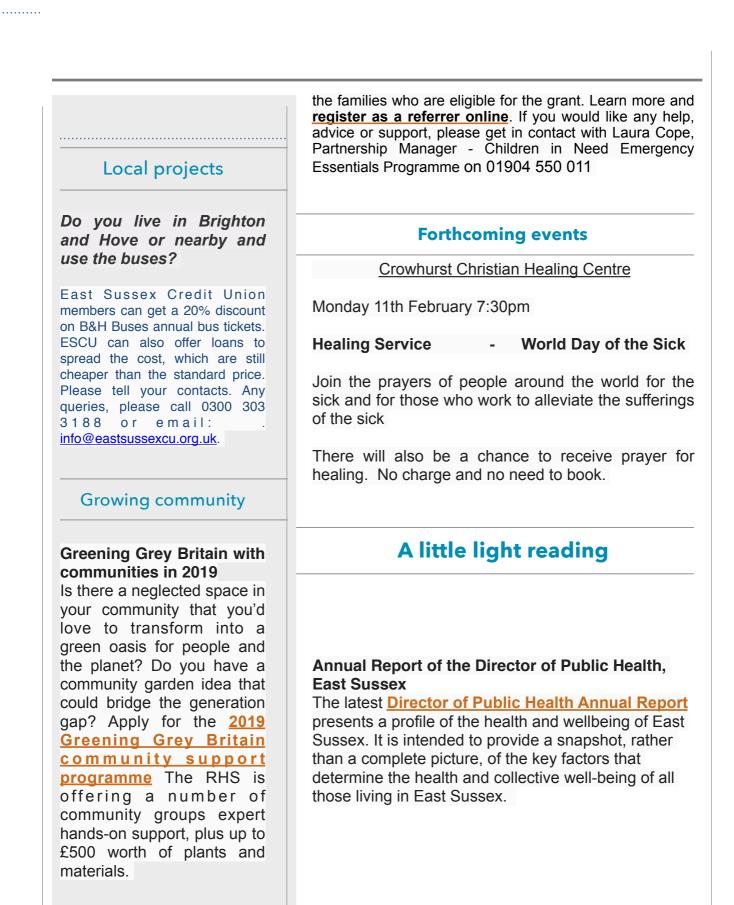
