## Do you know of a property that could help a Syrian refugee family?

The number of Syrians fleeing their homeland now exceeds 5 million, including 2.4 million children. All those resettled through the government sponsored Syrian Refugee Resettlement Scheme are identified by the Home Office in cooperation with the UNHCR and enter the country legally, direct from camps in the Middle East.

The scheme is looking for private landlords who might be willing to work with the local Council to provide a home for a Syrian refugee family. The scheme will pay deposits and housing costs and ensure maintenance on the property throughout the tenancy.

Do you live in Brighton and Hove?

Could you help with SWEP (Severe Weather Emergency Protocol) provision for those who are street homeless this winter?

SWEP is looking for volunteers to be present on the nights when SWEP is activated. The role of the volunteers will primarily be to support the staff team by helping to create a calm, friendly and welcoming environment.

There will be a rota with two volunteers on each night whether you will be needed will depend on the weather. SWEP is activated if the weather is due to drop below zero for one night or more or there is an Amber weather warning. You will be volunteering alongside a trained staff team and St Mungo's staff who know the people on the streets well. The set up time will be 6pm for an opening time of 6.30pm and finish at 10.30pm.
