
HOW TO GET THERE

Revd Steve Gendall – Steve was born in Zimbabwe where he grew up during its transition years. As a teenager Steve had a deep personal experience of God's love and later responded to his call to the priesthood. During 12 years as Rector of St Apollos the Irrigator in a very rural situation (once described as unfit for human habitation) he saw the Church grow and many lives changed. Steve, Veronica and their two daughters left Zimbabwe and he was appointed Rector of Lingfield and Crowhurst in Surrey where the family enjoyed learning about the English way of life for 10 years. Crowhurst Christian Healing Centre has been their home for the past 7 years where they have been experiencing God at work in different and exciting ways, for themselves and for the many guests who visit the Centre.

Susie Flashman Jarvis - Susie is an Executive Coach and Counsellor who understands all too well what it is like to be trapped in addiction. Her story of freedom is told in her autobiography Potholes and Belly-flops. She is passionate about seeing people freed from 'the ties that bind' and men and women in the corporate world who are caught up in the stress of 'always having to be on.'

The world of social media where only the best version of you is presented can result in behaviours being adopted that soothe the pain of not being enough. It is all too easy to seek refuge in gambling, alcohol, drugs, pornography, shopping, food and working too hard.

Susie believes that Jesus is the answer. Someone who knows us, warts and all and loves us just the same. And who loves us too much to leave us abandoned to our own coping mechanisms.

Denise Cross - Denise is part of the Executive Leadership of Ellel Ministries International having joined the ministry, with her husband, in 1993. Ellel Ministries, which started in Lancaster in 1986, is a teaching, discipleship and healing ministry which now has centres in more than 30 countries around the world. Denise is a passionate teacher of God's Kingdom truths and delights to bring understanding so believers can increasingly receive God's restoration and healing and can fulfil their unique destiny.
