

Palm Sunday

Make a paper 'Palm Cross'

You will need:

- A long thin strip of paper cut the same width across its length.
- A small piece of tape or blob of paper glue

1. Hold the paper strip horizontally



3. Fold this same top strip, from the centre, back and down, up and over again, to form a square at the back. It will still be a right angle at this point.



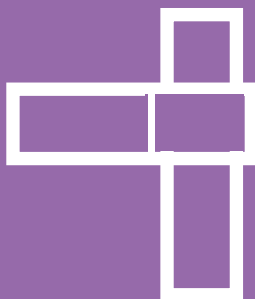
2. Bend the right end straight up from the centre to form a right angle.



4a. Bring the left strip forward and fold over the centre towards the right.
4b. Fold away from you and pull through the square at back, all the way.



5. Bend the top strip forward and put the end through the centre square to make an upright section of the desired length.



7. Fold the right strip back, put through the back square and secure in place with a piece of tape or blob of glue.



6. Fold the left hand strip backwards and put it through the back square. This makes the left crossbar and should be proportional to the upright section.
