5 - 12 December 2024

Spend the days leading up to Christmas in a magnificent alpine setting where the advent customs of its regions, towns and villages are the perfect antidote to the pre-Christmas rush. Be part of authentic advent traditions whilst visiting the Christmas markets in the picturesque villages of Maria Alm, Zell Am See and Berchtesgaden. Visit Oberndorf, learn the history of the famous carol Silent Night that originated here and visit the church of the composer Franz Xaver Gruber. Walk the Berchtesgaden Emmaus Trail and past the churches and chapels in the Berchtesgaden market and above the town and enjoy an afternoon horse-drawn sleigh ride. With so many extras included you will be able to enjoy the sounds of church bells, traditional carols and festive brass band music with the smell of fresh

cinnamon from Christmas treats and bubbling gluhwein as you wander the traditional Christmas markets. The emphasis is more on traditional clothing from local woolens, handicrafts, wood carvings and nativity scenes reflecting the true meaning of Christmas. We invite you to join us for our unspoiled celebration at this special time of the year.

TOUR INFORMATION

The cost is £ 1,999 per person sharing a double or twin room. The price is based on a minimum number of 25 participants. If the final number is lower than this, a supplement may be applied to the final invoice.

We stay at the Eder Hotel located in the village of Maria Alm.

The tour is on a half board basis with continental breakfast and, evening meal being served at the hotel. Two lunches are also included.

Touring is by air-conditioned coach and we will be accompanied by our tour manager who will look after the formalities of hotel check-ins, etc.

All entrance fees are included as well as gratuities; these will be disbursed locally to those that help us on our journey.

Flights are with **British Airways** direct between London **Gatwick** Airport to

Salzburg and all airport and security charges are included as well as a 23kg luggage allowance.

Not included

Travel insurance: this is essential. We require all travellers to have adequate cancellation and medical coverage for their journey. We recommend the policy with Holiday Extras who offer a comprehensive policy as well as yearly policies that also cover short UK overnight stays. See the back cover for details.

Single rooms: a limited number of single rooms are available at a supplementary cost of £175. For single travellers who do require single accommodation this should be requested when making a booking and, if a single room is available, the supplement will be payable.

Special Requests: should be noted at the time of booking.

Payments: a non refundable deposit of £400 per person.

The final balance is due 12 weeks before departure.

Final Travel Documents: will be sent to you two weeks before departure.

Late Bookings: please note that for bookings made within 12 weeks of departure, the price may increase due to the fluctuating cost of flights. If this arises, we will always discuss this with you before processing your booking.

OUR PILGRIMAGE

Thursday 5 December | TO SALZBURG Fly from Gatwick to Salzburg with British Airways. Fligh BA2624 departing at 06:35 arrives Salzburg at 09:35. Your tour manager Rena Bremer will welcome you. Transfer to your Hotel Eder, located in the center of the idyllic village of Maria Alm. This evening you have the chance to witness one of the Advent traditions of Austria, the "Perchtenlauf". Dinner in the hotel.

Friday | MARIA ALM

Use this morning to sleep in and get used to the wonderful mountain air and enjoy a great breakfast in peace and quiet. Later this morning Rena will meet you for a stroll through the village including a visit to the local parish church. Rich votive offerings testify to the supra-regional importance of this beautiful pilgrimage church. In the afternoon you take a horse-drawn sleigh ride to one of the snow-covered neighboring villages. After sunset you have the opportunity to explore the Maria Alm Advent market. Dinner at the hotel.

Saturday | ZELL AM SEE

After breakfast travel to Zell am See situated at the foot of the Schmittenhöhe mountain and on the shores of Lake Zell. During a city tour you will get to know the city's sights like St Hippolyte's Church, the town's main square Stadtplatz, and the tranquil lakeside Elisabethpark. After lunch (at own cost) we board the "Sternenschiff" (star boat) for a 1-hourlake cruise on lake Zell. After returning to the shore, you may wish to visit the city's Christmas market, the "Sternenadvent". Vibrant stars are reflected in the water of Lake Zell, the sweet smell of biscuits is in the air, and magical moments await. Return back to Maria Alm and enjoy dinner at the hotel.

Sunday | BERCHTESGADEN

This morning we celebrate Eucharist in the hotel. Today Austrian Christians celebrate the the Feast of the Immaculate Conception and you may choose to join Mass at the Maria Alm Parish church. Later today you drive to the Bavarian village of Berchtesgaden for an opportunity to discover the historic Rococo town center with its town houses, monastery church and royal palace. We visit the Advent market, before we walk the Berchtesgaden Emmaus Trail. It takes about an hour and takes you past the churches and chapels in the Berchtesgaden market and above the town. During Advent, the Emmaus Trail becomes a lantern trail: 75 oversized lanterns, illuminate the path. Return to the hotel for dinner.

Monday | SALZBURG

Today you will visit Salzburg, the city if Mozart and Sound of Music, overlooked by the famous medieval fortress Hohensalzburg. After a short walk through the old town you will board the funicular up to the fortress and experience a guided tour through the old walls. You will see the late Gothic state rooms and learn about the construction history of the fortressand and the story about the Salzburg bullwashers and let the Salzburg Bull a 500 year old mechanical organ - ring out! Free time to stroll through the streets of Salzburg or stop for lunch, or visit the famous Salzburg Advent market in front of the Dom. Afternoon visit to the famous pilgimage church of Maria Plain. Maria Plain, which is has been a beloved pilgrimage destination since the 17th century. Return to Maria Alm and enjoy dinner at the hotel.

Tuesday | JAKOBSKREUZ AND MARIA KIRCHENTAL

After an intensive day in Salzburg, you deserve a leisurely breakfast today. At 10 am you will leave to visit the largest accessible summit cross in the world, the Jakobskreuz. It is located on top of the summit of the Buchensteinwand, the most beautiful panoramic mountain in the Pillersee valley. To reach the cross, you aill ascend with a chairlift. Inside the cross there is a small chapel where you may stop for worship. You will enjoy an included **lunch** before we continue to the village St Martin bei Lofer, where you have to change to minibuses to reach Maria Kirchental. Alongside Maria Plain this place is certainly one of the mostvisited pilgrimage churches in the province of Salzburg. Return to Maria Alm and enjoy dinner at the hotel.

Wednesday 12 December | SILENT NIGHT TOUR

Today you are following the footsteps of the most famous Christmas song of the world: Silent Night. You drive to the village of Oberndorf to see the Silent Night chapel with a guided tour. Lunch is included and will be served in a nearby restaurant. Continue to Arnsdorf, where you will see the original house where Franz Xaver Gruber, the composer of Silent Night, used to live and teach. Visit the pilgrimage church of Maria im Mösl, which has been famous for pilgrimages since more than 800 years. En route back to Maria Alm for dinner.

Wednesday | HOME

Transfer to Salzburg Airport for your BA2625 flight departing at 10:25 and arriving Gatwick at 11:25.

Please note the itinerary may be subject to change due to local conditions and flights can also be subject to alteration but are correct at the time of printing. There will be quite a bit of walking on this pilgrimage, these historic sights are best explored on foot.
