## Parish Deprivation Score

A parish deprivation score is available for each of the 12,000+ Church of England parishes, which cover the whole of England. The parish deprivation score is a measure of relative deprivation across parishes.

The parish deprivation scores are based on the Government Indices of Deprivation and consist of an overall Index of Multiple Deprivation including seven domain indices, two supplementary indices and six sub-domain indices.

It is common to describe how relatively deprived a parish is by saying whether it falls among the most or least deprived 10% to 40% of all parishes.

All parishes are divided into 'deciles' – 10 equal groups – ranking between 1 (most deprived) and 10 (least deprived).
