The Church of England online portal for 2024 deadline for parishes to enter their Easter, October and Christmas data has been extended. Thank you to the many parishes who have submitted their data on time. This data allows us to see any emerging trends and is extremely useful for strategic planning. Anyone new to the portal who needs access please do get in touch and we can set you up as a user. Similarly, anyone who is locked out do let us know and we can reset it for you. Following your APCM the finance return is open until 28th June 2025, on the online portal, for parishes to submit their data.

Please remember to return your changes in postholders, electoral roll certificate and a copy of your accounts and annual report to us. This can all be done online and we encourage email copies of the accounts. For those registered with the Charity Commission you have until 31st October to submit your return for 2024 on their portal. Please note that if your income has gone over £100k, for whatever reason in 2024, and you are not registered,

you will now be required to register with them.

# VAT refund survey

The government has announced that the VAT refund scheme will continue in 2025. Please note the major change is that there will be a cap per parish (not per church) of £25,000 per annum of VAT that can be reclaimed. This is a major change as there was previously no cap annually. If you have large building works coming up and VAT refund was part of the plan please check the numbers. If you have had works done recently our advice is to claim as much refund as possible before the end of March when the cap will come into effect.
