Cornerstone platform

The ministry and mission of parish churches is mostly funded through the incredible generosity of those who give to it through money, time and talents. But when times are tough, financial struggles can seem overwhelming. The Cornerstone platform has been developed by the National Giving Team, with the aim that it will take you on a journey to understand your church's giving culture and financial situation. It aims to leave you with clear, simple steps to grow giving and income.

Cornerstone is supported by an online platform that helps show areas where you can focus your resources to get the best results when it comes to increasing the culture of generosity in your church. The platform has easy to follow step-by-step actions which are called Pathways. It also has an extensive grants database which talks you through how to write an application.

We have launched our first roll out of Cornerstone for a small number of churches in the diocese and we hope to do more workshops based in locations in each archdeaconry in the autumn. Church House vacancies

2 x School Effectiveness Officers

We wish to appoint two experienced senior leaders to help us deliver educational excellence and effectiveness across the 155 Church of England schools and academies that belong to the household of faith in the Diocese of Chichester.

As a result of the retirement of two members of the Education team we have a full time and a part time role (0.8) available from September. We are seeking candidates who can support the development of school improvement and Christian distinctiveness provision across our Church of England schools and academies.

Our vision for Education is to be "Deeply Christian, serving the common good." Based at Church House in Hove, we seek to live out our vision to "Know, love and follow Jesus".

The principal duties include:

- Providing advice and support to school leaders on strategies for improvement and raising standards in church schools
- Developing effective processes for school improvement based on monitoring, review and evaluation principles.
- Supporting church schools and academies in their preparation for and response to Ofsted and SIAMS inspections.
- Advising school leaders on the development of the distinctive Christian character and the promotion of spiritual, moral, social and cultural development in the life of their schools and academies.
- Our ideal candidate will:
- Be an experienced Headteacher with experience of delivering school improvement and educational excellence.
- Have the ability to build strong professional relationships, have challenging conversations and hold senior school leaders to account with sensitivity and understanding.
- Show evidence of good leadership and organisational skills and have the ability to prioritise tasks, risks and opportunities.
- Be a Christian and committed to the role that church schools play in the formal education and raising of standards.
