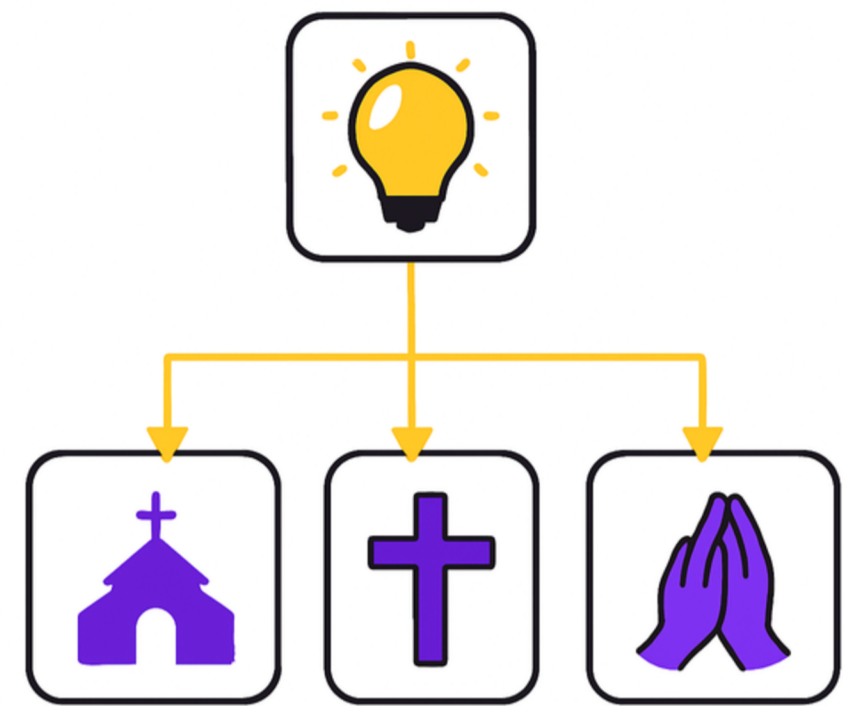


Vocations

Beginning a vocations journey



The vocations team in the Diocese of Chichester is here to work with you, and support you as you discern God's calling. The initial part of the process gives spaces for reflection, with a clear structure to support our initial work together



1. Initial discernment

You will need the support of your vicar, rector or chaplain, and so the first step is to talk with them. You might also want to talk with those who know you best- what are their thoughts?

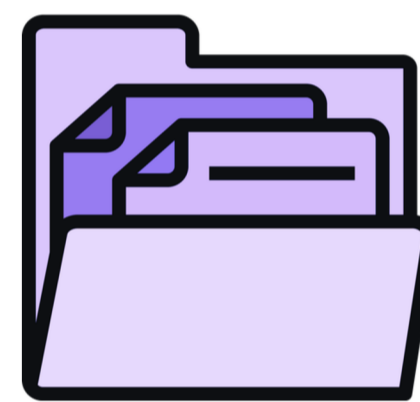

4. Vocations enquirer

If the team sense God may be calling you to something, then you will be paired with an experienced priest, called a vocations advisor, to support your reflections. You will also join others in a four session Vocations Enquiry Group.

2. Paperwork

If your parish priest or chaplain thinks there is something to explore then you should reach out to the vocations administrator. You will need to complete the Ministry Enquiry Form, and your priest will need to supply a reference. You will not be able to progress further until these are received.
