The role requires that you are gifted in evangelism and discipleship to continue to work alongside our current Children, Youth & Family Missioner to develop new faith enriched groups, whilst helping to also keep our current groups thriving and to ultimately bring more children, young people and families to understand the truth about Jesus, as we seek to flourish their spiritual growth whilst they explore a relationship with Jesus.

You will possess the following essentials:

- A heart for children and young people and a desire to see them coming to faith in Christ and growing in faith.
- An enthusiasm to lead, enable and develop our ministries to children and young people, offering biblical teaching and social activities to help build a life-long faith in Christ and to encourage personal growth.
- A passion to see children, young people, parents and carers become leaders within the Church and wider community.
- A practising Christian with a passion for supporting spiritual and personal growth in children, young people and their parents/carers.
- Experienced at working with youth, children, or families in a community or church setting (either full time paid or exceptional volunteering record).
- Strong interpersonal, organisational, and leadership skills, with the ability to work within a team and work on own self-motivation.
- A good knowledge of the Bible.
- Be a person of prayer.
- A good knowledge of safeguarding practices, specifically in conjunction with a Children, Youth & Family setting.
- Able to plan work, organise and meet deadlines, to cover the required workload flexibly within the demands of the job.
- Willingness to acquire new skills and undertake appropriate training.
- Good IT and admin skills with a competency in social media.
- A heart for the vision, work and mission of Seaford Parish.

Role Requirements:
